



## **Seeking Volunteers**

*The wardens and Vestry would like to hear from anyone who would be able to take on one of the following positions. Training will be given, and Vestry will support you — so you don't need to know everything in advance.*

### **Buildings & Grounds Committee members**

This group will keep an eye on the various buildings & other facilities we have here at Church on the Hill, and St Albans. Members of this committee will:

- Notice when things aren't right, and be prepared to do something about it.
- Be "go to" people for when others notice things aren't right.
- Help sort maintenance tasks into priority order, & make recommendations to Vestry.
- Take responsibility as a group for getting things fixed.
- Organise quotes and liaise with tradespeople.
- Work with a delegated Vestry person to keep Vestry informed.
- Meet regularly to discuss any buildings & grounds issues.

### **Parish Health & Safety Officer**

This position is a legal requirement, and for the right person it shouldn't be an overly onerous task. The Health & Safety Officer:

- Completes an annual inspection of the parish buildings and passes any safety concerns to Vestry and the Buildings & Grounds Committee.
- Works with Vestry to form a health & safety checklist.
- Visit all the ministry units in the Parish and ensures compliance with current health & safety practice.
- Maintains the hazard register and pass concerns to Vestry.

### **Parish Treasurer**

This is an important role in the Parish. As Treasurer you would:

- Chair finance committee meetings.
- Understand what a budget is, and take ultimate responsibility for ensuring the budget is followed.
- Take responsibility for signing off the accounts before they are sent to the Diocese.
- Work with Parish staff to set up systems for recording transactions accurately.

Taizé is an ecumenical form of prayer modeled after the Taizé community (an ecumenical Christian monastic community of brothers) founded in the 1940's by Br. Roger in Taizé, France. The purpose of the prayer is to foster reconciliation and peace among all people. Christians of all traditions share in this ecumenical prayer. The service consists of song (using the simple chants of the Taizé community), scripture, a service of light, a period of silence for meditation concluding with prayers for the world.
