**Billets for Choir Visit** - 24 members of the Choir of Christ's College Cambridge, England will perform at Church on the Hill at 7.30pm on Friday 10 July. They're one of the top choirs at Cambridge University, where the Anglican choral tradition flourishes; they sing music from the 16th Century to the present, English and European, unaccompanied and with organ. They regularly sing at high profile venues in London and before Christmas we completed a run of very successful concerts starting with Mozart's Requiem at St Martin-in-the-Fields, Trafalgar Square and moving through the Messiah and other Christmas repertoire at St John's Smith Square and other locations. In addition, they undertake an international tour every year; last year they travelled through Quebec and Ontario and the previous year the East coast USA from Boston through New York and other cities to Washington. The choir last came to NZ in 2006. We have agreed to host the Choir and need accommodation - 24 beds for 2 nights, Friday 10 July and Saturday 11 July.
