Taizé is an ecumenical form of prayer modeled after the Taizé community (an ecumenical Christian monastic community of brothers) founded in the 1940's by Br. Roger in Taizé, France. The purpose of the prayer is to foster reconciliation and peace among all people. Christians of all traditions share in this ecumenical prayer. The service consists of song (using the simple chants of the Taizé community), scripture, a service of light, a period of silence for meditation concluding with prayers for the world.

Reflection Questions

- What's your favourite recipe when cooking for a crowd? Or (if you don't cook) what's your favourite thing to eat when there's a group of you?
- What did Jesus mean by "feed my lambs/sheep"
- How do you build hospitality and manaakitanga (sharing of care and love) into your "outreach" to people?
- Next time you cook for someone or serve someone food make a point of serving it as a form of communion (even if it's secretly under your breath). You're sharing life with them!
