### Some information about Tax Credits (Donations)

- You can claim a tax credit if you're an individual (not a company, trust or partnership) and you earned taxable income (eg, salary, wages, benefit, self-employed income, interest) in the income year you're claiming for.
- A donation is a gift of money made voluntarily to a donee organisation, where there is no identifiable direct benefit to the donor, or the donor's family. A religious organisation donation is an unconditional donation made to a donee religious organisation or group. (e.g. Church on the Hill).
- The total donations you claim can't be more than your taxable income for the year.
- You can claim the lesser of 33.3333% of the total donations you've made, or 33.3333% of your taxable income. (e.g. If your income for the year was \$20,000 and you gave \$2,000 to Church on the Hill, you are eligible to receive a tax credit of \$666.66).

### A Request...

We ask that you prayerfully consider donating you tax credit to Church on the Hill. If you want to donate your tax credit, you can donate it through your envelopes or by direct credit to 03 0751 014369 001 Holy Trinity Church. All your donations are recorded so that you will receive a receipt for your donations after 31 March 2018 which you can again claim for a tax credit!
